The Council hereby REFUSES Planning Permission for the above for the following Reason(s):

(1) The proposed first-floor side extension would cause visual harm to the character and appearance of the streetscene. It would significantly reduce the existing gap at first floor level between the application property and No.3 Mamignot Close which would upset the prevalent pattern and rhythm of development along Mamignot Close and erode the relief and sense of spaciousness that the gap at first floor level currently provides. To permit the development would therefore be contrary to the National Planning Policy Framework 2021, Polices DM1 and DM9 of the Maidstone Borough Local Plan 2017 and the design guidance set out in the Council's adopted Residential Extensions Supplementary Planning Document.

(2) The proposed first floor extension would by reason of its proximity to the boundary, height, bulk, and mass, together with the position of front facing windows to No.3 Mamignot Close and the staggered relationship, would cause an unacceptable loss of outlook and represent an overbearing and overshadowing form of development harmful to the residential amenities to the occupiers of this neighbouring property, contrary to the National Planning Policy Framework 2021, Polices DM1 and DM9 of the Maidstone Borough Local Plan 2017 and the design guidance set out in the Council's adopted Residential Extensions Supplementary Planning Document.

13. Highway & PROW Matters.

<u>We are upgrading our Gas Network – Ware Street Area, Bearsted, Maidstone</u> We are writing to let you know about our project to upgrade our gas network in the Ware Street area of Bearsted. This work will upgrade our old metal gas mains and services with new plastic pipe. This essential work will ensure your community continues to receive a safe and reliable gas supply.

In consultation with Kent County Council our contractor, WCB Utilities who will be completing this project on our behalf, will start work in Ware Street during the week beginning 26th June.

Due to the position of the pipes in the road, and to ensure the safety of everyone around our worksite we will need to close some of the roads around our works area. While the roads are closed, there will be signed diversion routes in place and vehicular access will be maintained for residents and businesses where it is safe to do so.

The closures are currently programmed for the dates below, any changes to these will be publicised via https://one.network/uk and by advance warning signs placed at the closure points 2 weeks before work is due to start.

Ware Street: From week beginning 26th June with an estimated end date of 4th September. We will be working from the junction with Averenches Road to the junction with Thurnham Lane. As we move along the road, we will also need to close Hog Hill and then Yeomans Lane at their junctions with Ware Street.

Thurnham Lane: From 31st July with an estimated end date of 4th September. We will be working from the junction with Ware Street to the railway bridge.

We understand that people can get frustrated by roadworks, and therefore we only use traffic management that we feel is efficient enough to complete these works safely for ourselves and the public.

We are writing to residents and other local stakeholders to make them aware of our project and explain the details of our work. Please feel free to also share this information with anyone you think may be impacted by our project.
