Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is given that The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority, in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposes to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order is to place double yellow lines on the following length of roads in Maidstone:-
HOCKERS LANE – DYL - On both sides from its junction with Ware Street for a distance of 15 metres in a north easterly direction. **SANDY MOUNT – DYL** - (1) On its south side 3 metres east of the western boundary of 5 Sandy Mount for a distance of 88 metres in an easterly direction. (2) On its north side from the permit parking bays opposite number 7 Sandy Mount for a distance of 50 metres in a south easterly direction. **WARE STREET – DYL** - On both sides from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Hockers Lane for a distance of 35 metres in a south easterly direction. A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the proposed Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the proposed Order may be examined at Kent Highways & Transportation, Kent County Council, Kroner House, Eurogate Business Park, Ashford, TN24 8XU by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 7 February 2025 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations
